### LIEUTENANT COLONEL RASHIDA A. GRAVES

Lieutenant Colonel Rashida A. Graves is currently serving as the commander of the 23d Comptroller Squadron in the 23d Air Base Wing at Moody AFB, GA. She commands over 160 personnel between the Comptroller Squadron and 15 wing staff agencies, oversees customer service operations for 6,200 base and geographically-separated personnel, and leads management of a \$150M wing budget. She provides oversight of military, travel, civilian and vendor pay services, resource management, non-appropriated fund activities, base audits, and local banking amenities. She also serves as the command authority for all wing staff agency permanently assigned members.



Lieutenant Colonel Graves received her commission through Air Force ROTC at Virginia Tech, Blacksburg, VA in December 2004. Her assignments include weapons systems cost analyst, budget analyst, and commander's action officer at the Electronic Systems Center, Hanscom Air Force Base, Massachusetts; deputy chief, financial analysis flight, 6th Comptroller Squadron, MacDill Air Force Base, Florida; and weapons systems cost analyst, executive officer, and investment appropriation analyst for the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Air Force (Budget, Cost and Economics, and Programs) at Headquarters U.S. Air Force, Arlington, VA. She also served as the commander of the Butte Military Entrance Processing Station (MEPS) in Butte, MT. The mission of the Butte MEPS is to process individuals for enlistment or induction into the armed services, based on DoD-approved peacetime and mobilization standards.
